






# International Conference on Cancer Imaging

During the past 30 years Radiology has undergone an amazing change, which has not only revolutionized the practice of this specialty, but that of Medicine itself. At the heart of Radiology's rapid development are the recent advances in diagnostic techniques; Multi-Slice Computed Tomography (CT), Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) and Molecular Imaging.
